Parish Council Precept

The Precept is the way that the Parish Council raises money to cover their expenses for the year and is charged through the Council Tax System.

At the Parish Council meeting in January the Councillors unanimously voted to keep the total amount claimed for the precept the same as last year. Due to the way this is calculated by the Borough Council it will result in a small increase per household.
