You may have noticed that the new development on the site of the former shops in Mancetter is progressing well. The Borough Council asked if Mancetter Parish Council could name this development. As it is due to be completed during the centenary year of the end of the First World War, the Council decided to honour a soldier who had strong links to Mancetter.

A hundred years ago on 3rd June 1917 Sapper Joseph Jacob Cadman, aged 23, was killed in action.

After contacting his descendants for permission, many interesting facts have emerged and the Parish Council is hoping to produce a booklet in commemoration. Joseph Cadman Court in Cadman Close is due to be completed in early 2018, and an opening ceremony is being planned with family members present.

After nearly three years of hard work, the Mancetter Parish Neighbourhood Plan has finally been completed and independently examined. Now it is your turn! If 50% of voters agree that this represents their views then the plan will be adopted and will influence the future of the Parish in the years to come.

It is proposed that the Neighbourhood plan Referendum is to be held on **7th September 2017** at Mancetter Memorial Hall and Ridge Lane Community Hall. **Please put the date in your diaries and remember to vote.**

Mancetter Parish Council will meet on **25th July 2017 at 7.00pm** in The Schoolroom at St. Peter's Church where Councillors' will discuss the proposed housing development on Quarry Lane/Nuneaton Road.
