Autumn is fast approaching and it has been a busy few months for the Parish Council. As usual we have been liaising with other agencies and tiers of government to highlight issues around the parish; from anti-social behaviour to blocked drains, pollution, fly tipping and planning applications. We also maintain the churchyard, cemetery, allotments, rural footpaths and the village green. Hopefully you have enjoyed our floral displays in both villages in honour of the 60th anniversary of D Day.

Led by Parish Councillor Peter Mann, North Warwickshire MP Craig Tracey visited Mancetter along with our County and Borough Councillors Margaret Bell, Denise and Tony Clews. They produced and delivered questionnaires to obtain feedback from residents regarding the ongoing concerns over speed and traffic volumes. The Parish Council is working with residents to push for changes to the road layout and signage. **The Traffic Calming and Speed Awareness group** met at the end of May to apply for funding to improve road safety and to record the number of traffic movements. It will come as no surprise to you that hundreds of speeding vehicles pass through the village at all hours of the day and night particularly along Harpers Lane and Nuneaton Road. Unfortunately, the Police Crime Commissioner rejected our funding application and the County Council are refusing to replace the 30mph flashing speed sign on Nuneaton Road despite it being damaged along with the bus stop in another collision. Our County Councillor is fighting on our behalf to get it reinstated.

The Group is meeting again in September to continue to feedback issues and solutions to those responsible. Never underestimate the power of people working together.
